Allegations

This case resulted from a complaint submitted in June 2013 from a non-member. The complaint relates to an alleged trespass on private land, involving tree removal, road construction and subsequent log hauling activities. The complainant was not notified of the activities in advance and was subsequently informed that the issue was due to a provincial permitting error.

Decision

The registrar reviewed the complaint against Section 22 of the *Foresters Act* and also brought the case to the Complaints Resolution Committee (CRC). Due to the fact that the complainant did not identify a member of the ABCFP the consensus was that the complaint should not proceed to an investigation. We understand the concerns of the complainant are being dealt with in court, and a future complaint may proceed once the court process is done.

The case is now closed.
