Allegations

This case resulted from a complaint submitted on August 26th, 2013 by a member regarding the conduct of another ABCFP member. The complaint relates to concerns about the subject member's professional behavior in the review of the complainant's ongoing work.

The complainant alleges that the subject member had systematically and unfairly targeted his timber cruising work, during the check cruising stage over a period of 9 months. The complainant brought his concerns to the subject member, but was not satisfied with the response.

Decision

The registrar reviewed this complaint with the Complaints Resolution Committee (CRC) and it was agreed that there was insufficient evidence to proceed with the complaint. The registrar requested additional information from the complainant, but the complainant has yet to pursue the matter further or provide additional evidence.

The case file has been closed. A new complaint file will be opened should more supporting documentation be submitted.
