Case: 2015-03 A and B

Subject Member: Registered Professional Forester

Referred to: Complaints Resolution Committee

Date of Decision: July 2015

Allegations

This complaint was lodged by a member and included allegations against two Registered Professional Foresters. The allegations stemmed from an audit of forest practices and related to the RPFs' roles in auditing and reporting functions. The complainant alleged that the RPFs had contravened bylaw 11.4.4 by failing to accurately state facts, thereby negatively impacting the reputation of the complainant.

Decision

The CRC considered the allegations and the subject members' responses and found that there was insufficient evidence to indicate that the subject members had failed to accurately state the facts during the course of their auditing and reporting.

As per Bylaw 13.16.4, the CRC believed that there was insufficient grounds to support an investigation and recommended to the registrar that the case be dismissed. The registrar agreed with this recommendation and the complaint is now closed.
