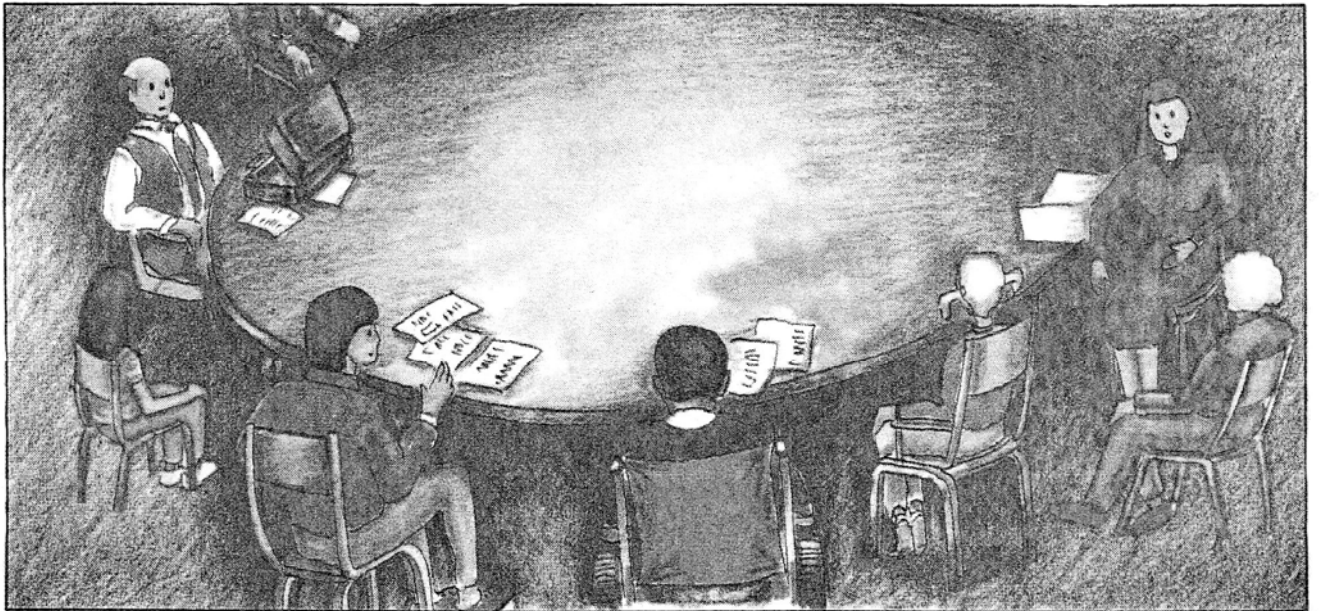


Who Wants What from the Forest?
